

#### Purpose of the Plan

December 2020 marked Owariasahi City's 50th anniversary as a municipal organization. The city's development up to the present is a testament to the diverse entities, including citizens, organizations, local communities, businesses, and government, that have come together, pooled their wisdom, and worked together to develop our city.

In recent years, there have been major changes in the lives of citizens and business activities triggered by the new coronavirus infection, as well as the need to respond to new administrative issues such as the declining birthrate, super-aging population, declining population, and increasing social security-related expenses.

The 6th Owariasahi City General Plan is formulated to clarify the future vision of our city and the direction of municipal administration, and to set as a guideline for promoting planned municipal administration, so that all people living and working in the city can enhance their sense of well-being without being left behind.

#### Structure and Duration of the Plan

The General Plan consists of a Basic Concept, Policy-specific Plans, and Implementation Plans.

#### (1)Basic Concept


The Basic Concept defines the direction of the municipal administration shared by citizens and the administration, and also serves as the guideline for city development. It consists of the Ideal Future Vision of the City, Basic Policies for City Development, and Basic Goals.

#### (2)Policy-specific Plan

In order to effectively promote policies to achieve the Basic Concept, the basic direction and system of policies are shown, consisting of Priority Packages and Policy-specific Guidelines.

#### (3)Implementation Plans

Implementation Plans provide specifics on how the initiatives set forth in the plans for each policy will be implemented.




#### Glossary

### Regional Characteristics of Owariasahi City


Owariasahi City has developed into a city where people can enjoy their daily lives, thanks to its geographically advantageous location adjacent to Nagoya City. The steady increase in population has created a virtuous cycle providing a convenient living environment, with stores and other facilities necessary for daily life located throughout the city. The city is also home to forest parks, farmlands, and reservoirs, which offer daily opportunities to experience the abounding nature and a calm living environment.




#### Characteristics of the Citizens

Many of our citizens live in owner-occupied houses and work outside the city. Many people have moved from outside the city to purchase their own homes in Owariasahi,indicating that they have chosen this city as their permanent home.


The city has developed into a residential city home to people with diverse residential histories, including people who have lived here for two or three generations and those who have recently moved to the city.

#### Background of residence in Owariasahi City





#### Population Projection

According to the results of the population projections based on the 2020 population, our city's population is expected to peak between 2020 and 2025 and then gradually decline but limited to about 1,000 people by 2035. As for the outlook of four age groups, the increase in the population aged 65 and over and the decrease in the population aged 14 and under are gradual, and the rapid decline in birthrates and aging of society occurring in many parts of Japan, is expected not to actualize.


The reason for this trend is that although the city's total fertility rate was not high at 1.39 (April 2015 to March 2020), there are many households that move into the city after childbirth.

#### Population Projections based on Four Age Groups (2025 and after)





#### Living in Owariasahi City


Many of our citizens feel comfortable living in our city. Daily life extends beyond the city limits to a wide area that includes neighboring municipalities such as Nagoya and Nagakute, but only a few people are dissatisfied with this.

In addition to the abundance of greenery, the tranquility of the city, and the high level of convenience, the city's easy access to Nagoya, which allows residents to enjoy the attractions of a large city without living in it, are thought to be factors that make the city easy to live in.


#### Is Owariasahi City livable?

#### Vision for the Future of the City

Making use of the good living environment that we have inherited from our predecessors, such as our lush topography and convenient access to Nagoya, our city has cooperated with citizens, various organizations, and businesses to develop into a "city to live in".

As we proceed with city development for the next 10 years, together with everyone who lives, studies, and works in our city, we have set forth the following "Vision for the Future of the City" (Future City Vision).

This vision for the future of the city is shared by all people involved with our city and is a common philosophy of city development that each person will work proactively to achieve.



### What is "Tsumugu"?

Originally, it meant extracting fibers from cotton or cocoons, and spinning them into thread. Today, it means weaving warp and weft threads together in planes and layers to form cloth, or "weaving history" or "weaving a story" over a long period of time, or two or more people working together hand in hand to make a connection.

#### Aspirations behind the Vision for the Future of the City

"Growing happiness" is a phrase that expresses the way in which each citizen, who plays a key role in city development, lives a secure and vibrant life in a comfortable and peaceful urban environment with a history and culture that have been handed down from generation to generation, how the various entities work hand in hand to achieve happiness of each individual, such as health, growth, and achievement of dreams, and how these efforts are accumulated and connected across generations.

"Building smiles" represents the way in which everyone in the city, at home, in the community, in parks, nurseries, kindergartens, schools, shops, businesses, and everywhere else lives a safe, comfortable, enjoyable, and fulfilling life while caring for each other and helping one another. This is how smiles are created all over the city and spread throughout.

"Growing happiness" achieves a city "Building smiles".

Furthermore, being "Building smiles" leads to "Growing happiness" even more.

The local administration will continue to promote city development with the cooperation of citizens, various organizations, and businesses so that as much "happiness" and "smiles" as possible will be created in our city.



### ■Basic Policies and Priority Packages for City Development

The declining birthrate, super-aging population, and population decline are environmental changes that will have a significant impact on city development. To appropriately respond to these environmental changes and achieve our "Vision for the Future of the City", we have established four "Basic Policies for City Development".

In addition, "Main Measures" to be focused on for each Basic Policy of City Development will be extracted and organized as Priority Packages, and related efforts will be coordinated across sectors and comprehensively advanced to improve results.

#### **Basic Policy for City Development (1)**

Adding "enjoyment" to "ease of living".

We will promote the creation of a safe and secure living environment, which is the foundation of "ease of living". We will also enhance and carry on the characteristics of a "livable city" where people can live in convenience and peace. Furthermore, by adding charm, vitality, health, and other joys that add color to life, we will enhance the quality of life and promote city development that will make current residents think, "It is easy to live here, and I want to continue living here" and for people outside the city to think, "I want to live in Owariasahi."







Furthermore, by spreading these efforts far and wide within and outside of the city, we will promote the development of a city that is attractive as a city where it is easy to raise children.

To achieve the "Vision for the Future of the City", "Basic Goals" are set for each of the eight areas, and "Policies" are defined for each of the Basic Goals, which serve as the measures to achieve the goals.

# Basic Goal 1 A city where people can live healthy and vibrant lives (health, medical care, and welfare)



Good health is the basis for enjoying a life that is true to oneself throughout one's life. Regardless of the need for nursing or medical care or the presence or absence of a disability, creating a society in which each individual has a life and purpose for living and supporting each other will lead to the happiness of all citizens.

To encourage citizens to take an interest in their health and actively engage in health promotion in their daily lives, we will enhance our health promotion programs and improve our counseling system during pregnancy, childbirth, and childrearing to respond to the declining birthrate. In addition, we will work to ensure a medical care system that is familiar and reliable, and to enable older people and people with disabilities to continue to live in their familiar neighborhoods with a sense of purpose and hope.

We aim to create "a city where people can live healthy and vibrant lives" by connecting all people across generations and fields and enabling them to support each other in the community.

#### Glossarv

Community-based society...A society in which local residents and diverse local entities participate, going beyond "vertical" divisions of systems and relationships between "supporters" and "recipients", and where people and local resources connect across generations and fields to create the lives and purpose of each individual, and the community together

Safety net... A general term for support for people in poverty, consisting of primary support (social insurance systems, etc.), secondary support (self-reliance support system for people in poverty), and tertiary support (public assistance system)

### Basic Goal 2 A city where children grow up healthy (children and childrearing)



Children are the hope for the future, and the entire society needs to support the growth of each and every child. Creating a community where people can give birth with peace of mind and where children can grow up healthy and happy will also lead to measures against the declining birthrate.

We will improve our childcare services to ensure the healthy growth of children. In addition, we will enhance our consultation system to address diversifying needs and concerns about childcare support, and provide consistent support from the time of pregnancy through childbirth and the childrearing period. Furthermore, we will take a child-oriented perspective to guarantee children's rights, and create a safe and secure place for children to spend time.

We aim to create "a city where children grow up healthy" by creating an environment where children can be raised with peace of mind and promoting measures to expand children's potential.

It is necessary to improve the quality of citizens' lives by further enhancing a comfortable and relaxing living environment and creating an environment in which it is easy to raise children, thereby creating an attractive and vibrant city where the younger generation will want to settle in.

We will create good urban areas, make the compact city\*, and reconstruct a vibrant central hub. We will create pleasant spaces with parks and other facilities, and build relaxing urban spaces with highly convenient and hygienic living environments. In addition, we will improve public transportation services and improve the road environment to ensure safe and smooth daily transportation.

We aim to create "a city that supports a high quality of life" by adding fun and attractive features while maintaining the rich living environment that has been systematically built up to now.

#### Glossary

Compact city...An urban structure in which housing and other facilities necessary for daily life are densely packed and close together, and well-developed administrative services are available

Transportation hub...A place where multiple or various modes of transportation are connected, such as a station square

National Tree Planting Festival...A central event of the National Land Afforestation Promotion held annually to deepen understanding of forests and greenery, which are the foundation of our rich national land

Flush sewage...People living in areas where public sewage is available have actual connection to the sewage system

### Basic Goal 5 A city where people can interact with each other and live with peace of mind (safety, security, civic life)



Interactions between people bring vitality and connections in our lives and give us a sense of security through mutual aid. Ensuring a safe and secure environment is also the most fundamental and important element of life.

In order to address various social issues in the community, we will proactively implement measures to revitalize the local community so that diverse and proactive activities by citizens, such as neighborhood associations and volunteers, will be carried out. In addition, to respond to various risks that threaten the safety and security of citizens' lives, such as large-scale disasters, fires, sudden illnesses, traffic accidents, and crimes, we will strengthen disaster prevention and mitigation measures, firefighting and emergency response systems, and promote traffic safety and crime prevention measures.

We aim to create "a city where people can interact with each other and live with peace of mind" by connecting various people living in the city while respecting each other's intentions.

In addition, we will promote the preservation of a comfortable living and sanitary environment, and promote a resource-recycling society\* by curbing waste emissions, thoroughly sorting waste, and recycling and reusing resources.

By incorporating an earth-friendly perspective in the daily lives and business activities of all citizens and businesses, we aim to be "a city where people lead eco-friendly lifestyles".
